Christina Chan Linton, age 78, of Charlotte, North Carolina, passed away peacefully on the morning of April 6, 2026, at home, surrounded by her loving family.

Born December 3, 1947, in Hong Kong, Christina was the beloved daughter of the late Alex Wing Sam Chan and Siu Ling Leung. Her Chinese family-style meals were legendary, bridging the cherished traditions of her Hong Kong upbringing with the new life she built in the West. Her extraordinary talent in the kitchen led naturally to a fulfilling

career in the hospitality industry, beginning as a flight attendant for Cathay Pacific Airways.
